

## Lake Cadillac Treatment for Invasive Plant Species

Lake Cadillac will be receiving spot treatments for Eurasian watermilfoil on August 13 and 14, 2013. A total of 25 acres are scheduled for treatment. The lake has a surface area of nearly 1,200 acres. This treatment will carry a short-term swimming restriction and an irrigation restriction if using water directly from Lake Cadillac for lawn and/or garden irrigation purposes. Areas that receive treatment will be posted with specific use restrictions that apply. The entire lake will not be restricted from swimming and/or irrigation as the treatment is occurring in specific areas. The irrigation restriction does not apply if irrigating with municipal water.
