Businesses celebrating an anniversary may apply for recognition at five (5) year increments (i.e. 5, 10, 15, 20, etc.) To participate in this program, please complete the application form, or download a fillable form online at <a href="https://www.cadillac-mi.net">www.cadillac-mi.net</a>. The form must be completed and submitted no later than 60 days prior to the business anniversary. At the city's discretion, the business will receive a proclamation recognizing its business anniversary at a regular City Council Meeting. It is recommended that businesses also issue their own press release regarding their anniversary for additional recognition.
