# **Council Communication**

Re: Water-Related Infrastructure CDBG Grant – Headworks System at the WWTP

This grant application includes the design and construction of a headworks for the City's wastewater treatment plant. This headworks project includes a screening system to remove large debris from influent wastewater and a grit removal system to remove smaller particles. The project also includes a headworks building, controls and metering equipment to monitor the system, all associated building needs such as plumbing, HVAC, electrical, and site restoration.

This project will reduce wear on the downstream equipment which will, in turn, reduce maintenance and repair costs. The treatment plant will run more efficiently, increase capacity, and reduce pollutants re-entering the environment by removing inorganics from the wastewater. City staff will no longer need to manually collect the large debris, and can dedicate their time to other projects.

The grant request is for \$2,000,000.

The City/Local match is \$919,000.

The current CIP has the following line items allocated from the Sewer Fund:

Cleaning Anaerobic Digestor	(2025)	\$ 75,000
Channel Monster	(2026)	\$ 45,000
Muffin Monster	(2027)	\$ 16,000
Screen	(2028)	\$400,000
Grit Removal	(2028)	\$350,000
TOTAL	,	\$886,000

An additional \$33,000 from the Sewer Fund will be needed to make up the difference of Local Match.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Cadillac desires to request \$2,000,000 in CDBG funds to construct a headworks including a screening and grit removal system, building for equipment, and associated piping; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Cadillac commits local funds from its Sewer Fund in an amount up to \$919,000; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project is consistent with the local Community

Development Plan as described in the Application; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will benefit all residents of the project area and

58.80 percent of the residents of the City of Cadillac are low and moderate income persons

as determined by an income survey approved by the Michigan Economic Development

Corporation; and

**WHEREAS**, local funds and any other funds to be invested in the project have not been

obligated/incurred and will not be obligated/incurred prior to a formal grant award,

completion of the environmental review procedures and a formal written authorization to

obligate/incur costs from the Michigan Economic Development Corporation.

resolves as follows:

1. The City of Cadillac hereby designates the Mayor as the Environmental Review

Certifying Officer, the person authorized to certify the Michigan CDBG
